In the days before the internet, you had to rely on the wisdom of your local guitar store, a couple of magazines, and your gut instinct. In fact, without the internet, you probably weren't aware it even existed. These days things are different. Thousands of guitars are available to you at the click of a button. You can find everything you need online, from any kind of guitar you could imagine, to amps, strings and even some top-rated guitar lessons for beginners. Is it just something to learn on. Will you be upgrading in a year or two when you start thinking about forming a band, gigging, and recording. However, in that superbudget market there is a lot of garbage, so be careful. For additional inspiration, make sure to check out this electric guitar list. Here's a brief picture of some of the most important components that make up a guitar, and what you should look out for when browsing. The main difference between them is the way the bodies are constructed, and the amount of resonance they produce. It allows for louder sounds and more sustain, while avoiding the feedback issues that affect some hollow bodied instruments at higher volumes. For the rest of this anatomical breakdown we'll focus on solid body guitars. Again, there's no right or wrong, and a neck wood is never going to sway your decision. There are a variety of shapes and profiles, and what you go for will depend on personal preference and playing style. Without bogging you down in the details of how they work, the singlecoil is the classic original pickup, which typically offers a bright and sparkly sound. However you can still play fast punk rock powerchords with a singlecoil, just like you can play an upbeat country number with a humbucker! Guitars with two or more pickups will come fitted with a pickup selector switch to quickly change between them. Most guitars will feature 22 frets, although those more rock and metal-inclined will sometimes offer 24, allowing you to reach higher notes.

It's only as you grow into the instrument you'll find what works best for you. Both have their pros and cons. However, tremolo bridges can affect tuning, unless the bridge and nut locks. Again, it's all down to personal preference. For a summary that covers everything we've talked about, check out this useful video. The main advantage of a solid body guitar for beginners is that they are easier to control in front of an amplifier. Solid body guitars are often simpler to hold as well, as hollow models tend to be a bit bigger in size. If you can aim higher than a superlow budget model, you will be rewarded with upgrades such as a smoother, flatter neck and an easier playing experience allround. With so many guitar brands and models on the market, manufacturers have had to up their game to ensure their guitars meet a better standard at a lower price. Why waste money if you aren't sure if you'll stick to it. This will save you money in the long run as you won't have to upgrade so soon and will give you a guitar that will be ready for performance when you are. It's therefore wise for beginners to go with a thinner or lighter wood body such as basswood, as well as an easy-to-hold body shape, such as a Les Paul, Telecaster or Stratocaster instead of a Flying V, or something similarly awkward. For example, they may fancy two humbuckers with coil-splitting capabilities, as well as individual volume and tone controls for each pickup. However, all of this would be excessive for a complete beginner, who would be better off with two humbuckers, one master volume and one master tone control. The reason being that adding a variable such as tremolo aka the whammy bar isn't likely to be that useful when you are just learning your first notes and chords. You will still be able to hear yourself playing, although very quietly. Also, by not having an amp, you are also missing the important response and feedback that an amp can offer you on your playing techniques.

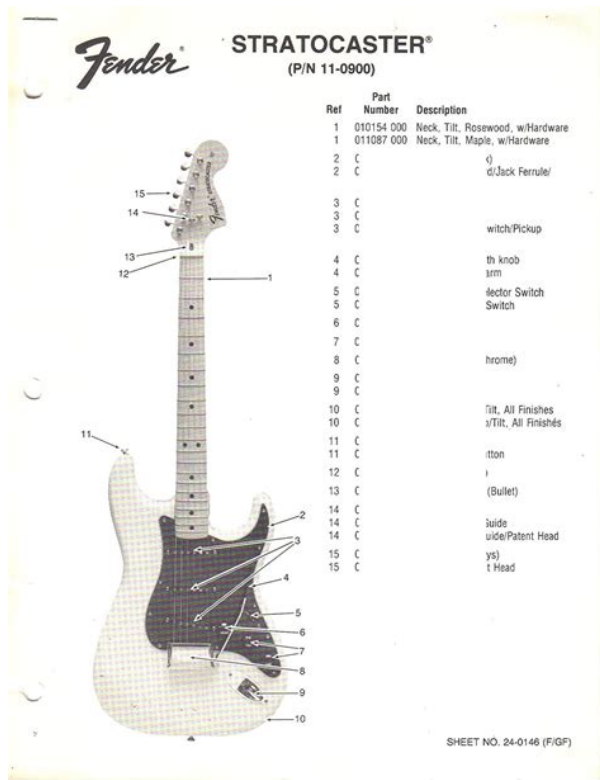

Because of this, electric guitars are built with hardware that makes the process of changing strings very quick and easy. Of the three types of guitars — steelstring acoustic, classical, and electric — you can change the strings on electric guitars most easily by far. There's no big trick to this. You can cut the wire and unwind it from the post, or, if you want to save it, unwind the tuning mechanism until you can remove the string. The ball holds the string just as the knot at the end of a piece of thread holds a stitch in fabric. This procedure is the same for almost all electric guitars. However, there are a few exceptions, such as those fitted with a Floyd Rose mechanism. Be sure that the strings go into the correct slot in the nut. Leave enough slack between the bridge pin and the tuning post to enable you to wind the string around the post several times. These devices also enable quick string changes, because you simply lay the string in the slot at the top of the post, kink it, and begin winding. You don't even need to leave any slack for winding. Leave enough slack for winding. This step is a bit tricky and requires some manual dexterity but so does playing the guitar. Keep your eye on the post to ensure that as the string wraps around the post, it winds down, toward the headstock surface. The string won't hold the tuning for very long in the beginning because it's still stretching. After you tune them up, gently stretch each string in a few places and retune. Do this three or four times and your strings will start to stay in tune. You might find it easier to use a tie wrap to hold the wires together while soldering.

There is a handle on the side of the body placed so that the neck of my guitar was at a 45 degree angle to the floor when I carried it. It also had two straps on the back of the body, allowing you to carry it like a backpack, a feature I found very helpful. I had to really smoosh my 8.5x11 music folder



into the bag in order to close the zipper. If you need something to travel with, spend a little extra for a padded bag. But if you are looking for something to make carrying your guitar easier or, as others have said, protect it from dust and spills, this is a very economical solution. Please try again They have a pouch in front, carry handle, and back pack straps and they are all well reinforced and cross stitched so that you can trust them when yanking the guitar up to carry it, and the two zippers open the bag all the way so it is easy to get the guitar in and out. The material is of medium thickness not thin and it is very well put together. I use the bags for all types of electric guitars, and they all fit with no problems. You can store your guitars on a stand, hung by the carry handle, or on a wall hanger, as they are not padded. I use a piece of velcro strap right under the head just to make it easier to hang on an Off The Wall hanger which is the only type of hanger I will use. Do not store a lacquer finished guitar in this bag, or the rubber coat will separate from the nylon material. What else can I say; for 9 bucks. I have not found a better bag for less money. The zipper contains two clasps allowing for easy rearrangement of the opening point of the bag. The size has a nylon handle for carrying by hand and the back has two adjustable straps for slinging over your back. As far as quality goes, Id wager this thing could take the beating from regular daytoday use, but Id avoid swinging or throwing it around as the straps may break though Im making it sound more delicate than it is.
